CCTV PRIVACY NOTICE

CCTV operates outside the school building(s). The school uses CCTV for the following purpose(s):

- To increase the personal safety of staff and visitors by reducing the fear of crime and providing a highly visible deterrent to potential offenders
- To obtain visual evidence of bullying, misbehaviour, vandalism and/or related incidents
- To protect the school building and their assets
- To support the Police in a bid to deter and detect crime
- To assist in identifying, apprehending and prosecuting offenders
- To protect members of the public and private property
- To assist in managing the school

The school's lawful basis for the use of CCTV is:

- The processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest e.g. for the preventative purposes of protecting staff and visitors
- The processing is necessary for the school's legitimate interests to prevent vandalism, theft and damage to school assets
