I may be a little muddy from the mud kitchen but I have learnt how to mix things together to make a mud pie or potion.

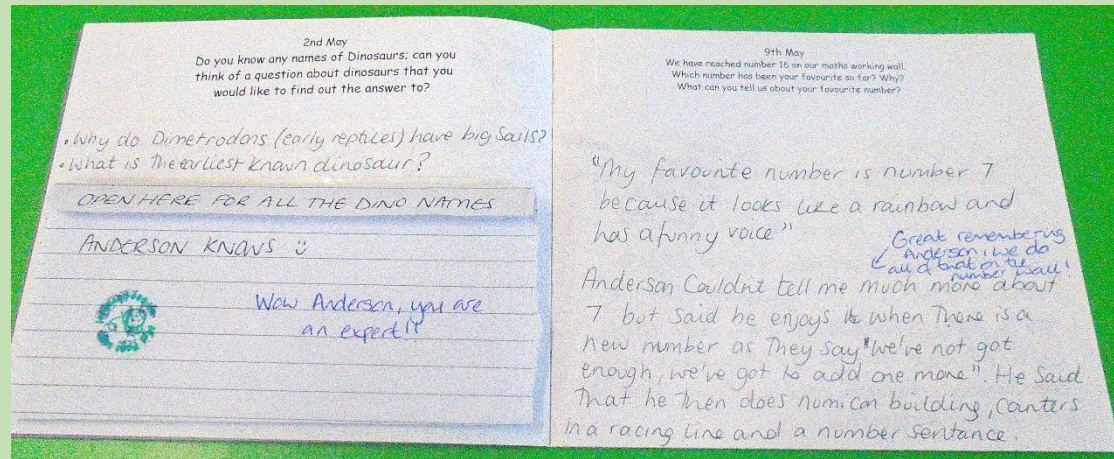
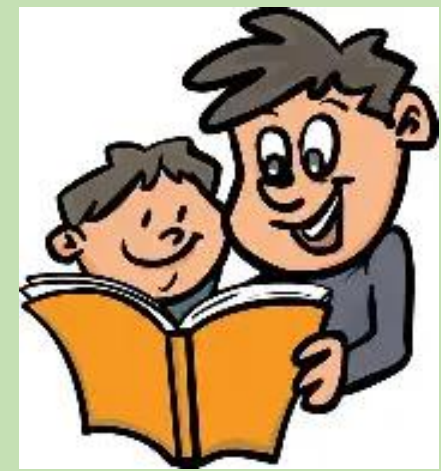

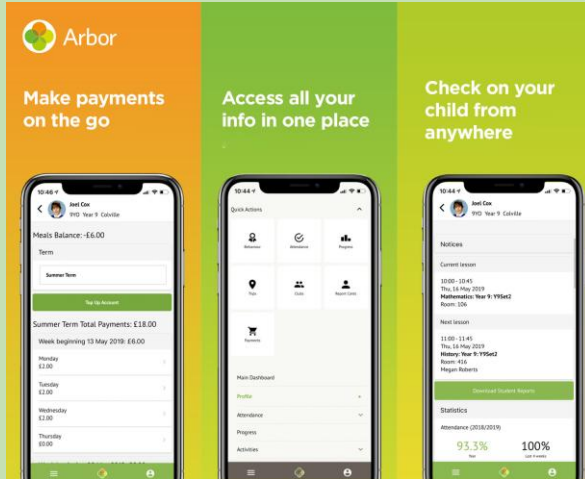
