Who are HPCN?

- HPCN - Hampshire parent carer network are the formal department of education local Parent Carer Forum for SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities).
- HPCN works with Hampshire County Council, and Hampshire ICB to coproduce and improve services for SEND across Hampshire.
- We offer free support groups, information, professionally supported workshops and events.
- Future In Mind (FIM) program, puts people who are waiting for either diagnosis or clinical help from CAMHS, in workshops and support groups with CAMHS professionals now, rather than waiting years.
- Bridging the GAP (BTG) program works with parents and carers of young people aged 14-25 who are going through a mental health transition, to Inform and make the transition smoother.
- Parent Led & Meet the SEND events, gives parent and carers access to SEND teams and management to ask questions to those that they might find harder to access.
- We work across Hampshire, linking parents and carers to the right professionals.
- We work to make sure you get the services you need in a way that works for you by feeding back to those who are responsible for them.
