Year 1 Trip to Longdown Activity Farm - Wednesday 17th June 2026



In Summer Two term our topic is farms and we have an exciting visit arranged for our Year 1 children to Longdown Activity Farm on Wednesday 17th June 2026.

We will be travelling by coach (seat belts fitted) to Longdown Activity Farm near Southampton. We will have the opportunity to visit the dairy, see the animals in the field, discuss the changes from young to adult animals and help with feeding the animals.

We believe that by taking children on educational visits, we enhance and broaden the curriculum we are able to offer. Off-site activities also help to develop a child's personal and social skills.

Please ensure your child arrives at school promptly for 8.45am on the day and collection time will be the normal time of 3.15pm.

However, as you will appreciate costs continue to rise and we would welcome a voluntary contribution of **£23.60 per child**. Although we are asking for a voluntary contribution should there be insufficient money raised through contributions to fund this trip it may not go ahead. We never request that you pay more than your child's proportion of the cost of the trip. This is detailed in the *Governors' Charging Policy*. Thank you to all the parents who have paid already. There are still some payments that are outstanding; please could you settle these as soon as possible on the Arbour app.

Please note the following information

- If your child needs an epi-pen or an inhaler please bring two named epi-pens/an inhaler and spacer from home on the day (as per the medical questionnaire).
- If your child requires travel sickness medication please give it them before they come to school.
- Please provide your child with a packed lunch and a couple of drinks (NO fizzy drinks or glass bottles) in a named bag - this will be stored in a safe place during the visit and will return home with your child.
- We will not be having snack time so you may want to give them a bigger breakfast to tide them over until 12:30pm.
- Children do not have to wear school uniform - please send them in sensible clothes including long trousers. They will also need a sunhat, sun cream and a waterproof coat.
- Wellies are a must if there is rain forecast. Please ensure your child is wearing shoes that are appropriate for the weather on the day we are going.
