Our Curriculum

English: Diary writing and Seaside Poetry

Maths: Position & direction, statistics and solving problems

Geography: Seashores - physical and human features

History: Seashores in the past

Science: Plants

RE: People Jesus Met

Art: Observational drawing and painting

PE: Net and Wall games and Athletics

PSHE: Growing and Changing

ICT: Questioning and presenting ideas

Music: Oceans

The children will also have phonics, handwriting and SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) lessons.
